

Who are we?

Carmarthen Breakthro' is a small, independent charity that provides leisure activities for children, aged four - 18, with severe learning difficulties and autism who live in the Carmarthen area.

What do we offer?

We run a Saturday club throughout the year and various play schemes during the School holidays.

What do we do?

We endeavour to meet the individual needs of each of our children. Every child has their own likes, dislikes, needs strengths and weaknesses and it is our aim to assess these needs and provide the suitable care.

Activities available

We are fortunate to have a soft play room, a sensory room, a touch-screen computer, a large outdoor play facility, musical instruments, art and craft activities as well as various books and videos.

What care do we offer?

Our coordinator and assistants are supported by a team of highly qualified staff and volunteers who have all undertaken the necessary training to provide 1:1 care (2:1 if necessary), for our children. We ensure that the children are supervised and looked after at all times.
